

## PAYMENT

The publication fee policy of the scientific journal “Bulletin of Postgraduate Education” has been developed in accordance with Resolution No. 796 of the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine dated 27 August 2010 and governs the procedure and conditions for payment of additional paid services related to the preparation, peer review, and publication of scholarly articles.

The journal is a non-profit scientific publication. The editorial board does not pursue profit – all funds received from APC (Article Processing Charge), are directed entirely towards covering the actual costs of editing, peer review, technical support, archiving, and promotion of the journal.

Open access to content is made possible through the payment for scholarly editing of articles, which is made by the author, their institution, or another authorised party.

### 1. Submission and Peer Review of Manuscripts.

The journal does not charge any fee for manuscript submission or peer review. The APC is collected only after a manuscript has successfully completed all stages of peer review and has been accepted for publication.

### 2. Purpose and Use of the APC.

The APC covers the following costs:

- scholarly and copy-editing, typesetting, and formatting of tables and figures;
- administration of the peer-review process;
- article archiving, website maintenance and support (hosting, technical assistance);
- promotion of the journal and individual articles (content dissemination, database updates, SEO support);
- layout design and printing;
- informational support for authors and readers.

The publication fee per page of an article is UAH 90.98; the fee for assigning a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) is UAH 85.00.

Third-cycle (doctoral) students enrolled in state-funded programmes are exempt from all fees for article processing, peer review, and publication, provided that the submission is single-authored.

Article processing fees are payable by the author upon a decision by the editorial board to accept the article for publication. Payment is made using the banking details sent to the corresponding author together with the letter confirming the final approval of the publication text, following endorsement of the issue contents by the editorial board and the Academic Council of the University of Educational Management.
