Requirements for the design and submission of scientific articles:

Conference participants are invited to submit complete and original research articles (6-12 pages), including review articles, teaching materials, futurology, through the EasyChair platform (<https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=pdsdig2020>) by September 20, 2020. / expert articles on conference topics.

The submitted articles will be reviewed by three members of the program committee on the criteria of technical quality, relevance, originality, relevance and transparency. The program committee uses these reviews to determine the articles that will be accepted for presentation at the conference. The results of the review will be sent to the authors by e-mail together with the comments of the reviewers (if available).

The main requirements for the design of the text of a scientific article:

1. The article should be:
 - a) in fact, correct and reasonable;

b) original (not published elsewhere in part or in full, as well as not submitted to other publications for simultaneous consideration);
c) presented at the conference (at least one author of each article must be present at the conference);
d) relevant to the conference;
e) issued in accordance with the requirements (a sample of the article is attached).

2. The number of references in the list of used sources must be at least 10.

3. Self-citation should not exceed 10%.

4. There should not be more than five authors in one article.

5. A maximum of two articles by one author is accepted.

6. Authors are encouraged to contact the Publications Ethics Committee (COPE) on all aspects of publication ethics (<http://publicationethics.org>) and to strictly adhere to the ethical rules described in <https://www.shs-conferences.org/about-the-journal-publishing-policies-ethics>, in particular:

a holistic study is not divided into several parts to increase the number of publications submitted at different times in the same or different collections or journals ("salami-publication");

no data (including images) is fabricated or tailored to the author's conclusions;

no other people's data, text or theories are presented in such a way as if they belonged to the authors ("plagiarism"); appropriate references are provided to works from which the material is taken almost verbatim, summarized and / or paraphrased; quotation marks are used for literal copying of material, and permissions for material protected by copyright;

consent to the submission was obtained from all co-authors and responsible departments of the institute / organization where the work was performed, in advance;

all authors, whose names are mentioned in the article, have made a significant contribution to scientific research, and share the collective responsibility for the reproducibility of its results.

Parameters for formatting the text of a scientific article:

PDSDig-2020 uses the two-column EDP Sciences format for articles, so carefully follow the SHS Web of Conferences Editorial Guidelines (https://www.shs-conferences.org/doc_journal/woc/shsconf_editorial_guidelines.pdf) and use the Microsoft Word template when preparing your articles. (https://notso.easyscience.education/umo_2col.doc).

The procedure for submitting a scientific article:

If you have never worked with EasyChair before and therefore do not have an EasyChair account, create one by clicking the "create an account" link in the login form. Follow the instructions to create your account, and then sign in to EasyChair. You will be invited to enter the PDSDig-2020 area as an author. On the PDSDig-2020 New Submission page, please fill in the submission forms according to the instructions.

Conference form: online format.
